Dear Mr. Donnelly:

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) received your letter on December 8, 2010, proposing a global alternate method of compliance (AMOC) to paragraphs (a) & (h) of Airworthiness Directive (AD) 98-23-03.

The Anchorage Aircraft Certification Office (ACO) approves your global AMOC proposal to paragraphs (a) & (h) of FAA AD 98-23-02 to alternately install the aft check cable in the aft location shown in the installation instructions for the LH4000 (Airglas Manual No. LH4000-105, Revision A, dated July 11, 2005) or at the rear float attachment fitting location installed per FAA approved float installation.

This AMOC applies to all airplane serial numbers, certificated in any category, that have either Airglas Engineering Company, Inc. (AECI) Model LW3600-180 (Single Position) or Model LW3600-180A (Two Position) fixed penetration wheel skis installed in accordance with Supplemental Type Certificate (STC) SA213AL:  
Cessna 180, 180A, 180B, 180C, 180D, 180E, 180F, 180G, 180H, 180J, 180K  
Cessna 185, 185A, 185B, 185C, 185D, 185E, A185E, A185F

This AMOC is transferable with the aircraft to an operator who operates the aircraft under U.S. registry.


Before using this AMOC, notify your appropriate principal inspector, or lacking a principal inspector, the manager of the local flight standards district office/certificate holding district office.

All provisions of FAA AD 98-23-02 that are not specifically referenced above remain fully applicable and must be complied with accordingly.

The Anchorage ACO will revoke this AMOC if the Anchorage ACO later determines that this AMOC does not provide an acceptable level of safety.
